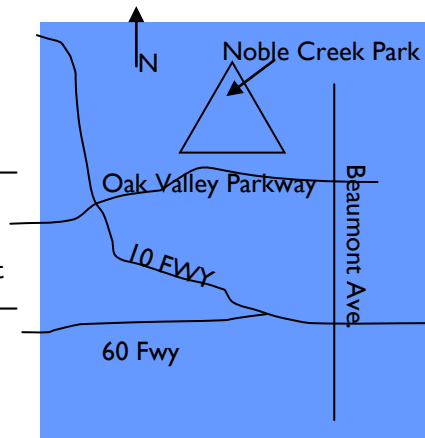

## Park Amenities

### Dog Park

### Ball Fields

We have seven lit fields available and plenty of warm-up areas in the meadow.



### RV Sites

Twenty-four RV sites with full hook-ups, \$30. per night. Dry sites for \$15. per night.  
A dump station for those just passing through, \$10.

### Picnic Area

There is a picnic area near the RV sites. All surrounded by beautiful trees.

### Horse Arena

An arena for your horse riding pleasure.

#### Rental Rates:

\$300 per day, \$75 per day for lights, \$75 per day for tractor & implement.

#### Open Arena Light Fees:

\$45 per month = 4 - 2 hour sessions

\$90 per month = 8 - 2 hour sessions

\$10 per hour with a 2 hour minimum
