Subject: Approval of the Sale of House at Danny Thomas Ranch to the District

Background and Analysis:

On December 28^{th} , 2020 the Board approved a resolution accepting the donation of approximately 123 acres of land from TSG Cherry Valley, L.P. Assessor Parcel Nos. 407-200-011-1, 407-210-001-3 (portion), 407-210-001-3 (portion), 407-200-009-0, 407-210-004-6, 407-210-002-4, and 407-200-012-2.

On June 8th, 2022 the Board approved Resolution #2022-01 authorizing the transfer of 121 Acres of land to the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District. The Foundation did not transfer approximately 2 acres of the land that contains the single family residence.

Staff recommends the sale of the 2 acres containing the single family residence to the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District.

Fiscal Impact:

The Foundation will no longer have to pay property taxes on this portion on the property, a savings of \$18,911.22 a year.

Recommendations:

Staff recommends that the Board review, comment and approve the sale of the 2 acres of property to the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Recreation and Park District.
